The meeting was called to order by **KP** at 19:30.

# 1. John Warren 80th Birthday

John celebrates his 80<sup>th</sup> birthday this evening. Many congratulations and best wishes on this major landmark.

# 2. Minutes of last meeting on 17 November 2016

Revision 1 was accepted by the committee and duly signed by the Chairman, along with Revision 0 of the previous meeting from 28 September 2016.

# 3. Treasurer's Report

There have been a few events since the last meeting.

The Dorchester event that will be held on Monday 06 February is showing a loss, due to the requirement to pay for a venue in advance.

There have been expenses for coaching courses and equipment.

The payment for the Caddihoe Chase includes the portion payable to WSX

Caddihoe Chase final balance will show a sizeable profit.

The club has a lot of cash at its disposal, and we need to think of efficient and beneficial ways to spend some of it.

## 4. **Equipment**

- 4.1. Equipment Shed: Wimborne Cemetery will not be renewing the lease, and we need to vacate before 01 April. The most convenient time will be in the weeks following the Compass Sport Cup event on Sunday 12 March. Flags, signs, and commonly used equipment can be spread around 3 locations in the care of AH, CB, and AF. Remaining equipment can be looked after by AH.
- 4.2. Start Clock: A new one would be useful, but they are believed to be prohibitively expensive.

#### **ACTION: Look for Cheaper Alternatives: ALL**

- 4.3. <u>Lightweight carbon-fibre stakes and plates</u>: **CB**: suggestion to purchase 20. Cost approximately £400. The committee approved the purchase.
- 4.4. <u>SI Cards:</u> **BE:** Some of those used for schools and coaching are in a shabby state. Should we purchase more?:
  - **CB/DK:** There are better ones in our possession, that can be made available if the shabby ones become unusable. We can also borrow from WSX. We shall probably need to purchase more next year.
- 4.5. <u>Compasses:</u> **KP:** Should we have some available to borrow? **BE:** This would be useful, especially if we purchase a variety of types: thumb and baseplate. The committee agreed

#### **ACTION: Purchase 8 compasses: BE**

4.6. Moors Valley POC Posts: **CB:** Rather than attach base plates to the POC posts, we could drill a hole through the post, and then attach the SI box using a gripple.

# 5. Website Members Area

**DK:** Mike Kite has created a Members Area. For the moment it contains a couple of map files and a document, just so that it is not empty.

We could upload the mapping library to this location as .pdf files, for general access.

Or, we could upload OCAD files, to be accessed only by librarian and webmaster.

Any files uploaded need to comply with a standard naming convention, with the date first. For

example: YYYYMMDD\_Name

The general consensus was that the mapping library can be present here, in OCAD and .pdf, controlled by **AF.**

27 members have attended. Several still have not. We need to hold another workshop. **CB** will talk to those outstanding and arrange a convenient date.

## 7. Recent Events & Meetings

#### 7.1. Sat 10 Dec 2016 Potterne Park Informal and Night League

All good. Went well, made a profit.

### 7.2. Mon 26 Dec 2016 Ringwood North Boxing Day Canter

An outstanding success, drew a huge turnout. People are prepared to travel some distance to this event.

One possible improvement would be to try and eliminate the long download queue. The nature of a mass start for a score event means that everyone finishes roughly the same time.

**CB:** Another fast splits printer would speed up the download process.

There are 2 download points

**ACTION: DK** to look for a suitable splits printer. During the meeting, one was found on ebay for £125 + £12 postage; duly purchased before the meeting finished.

The download tent was not in the perfect location.

Map distribution before the start was not perfect. Competitors stood in a big group. It was difficult to keep track of who had a map and who did not. This would be improved by having an area cordoned off as a holding pen for competitors who already had a map, and/or a funnel to channel competitors past the map distributors.

We were lucky there were not many EOD competitors – this would have been tricky for the computing team to handle. We shall not close the pre-entries early. 21:00 on Christmas Day is traditional. If shut earlier, there would have been much fewer entrants. This year's large turnout was largely due to favourable weather. Many competitors make the decision to enter only after seeing the forecast. If entries had closed, it could be expected that fewer would show up.

More maps should be printed than there are entries.

Maybe more toilets are needed.

Maybe more than one mass start? **DECISION: No.** 

Mulled wine and mince pies was a total winner. Maybe next year roast some chestnuts as well.

13.1. Access to Ibsley and Rockford Commons

Email from National Trust on 13-Jan-17, seemingly withdrawing access permission, and suggesting Foxbury instead, promoting its improved toilets and facilities.
