The event is open to BOF Members and Non-Members.

### Location

**Stonebarrow & Golden Cap, Charmouth (GR SY 390 935)**

From Bridport take the A35 west towards Honiton. From Axminster take the A35 east towards Bridport. Turn off for Charmouth from the dual carriageway at grid ref SY 375 937. Continue 500m. Where the road bends right, turn sharp left into Stonebarrow Lane. Follow the single lane road uphill to the venue where you'll be directed to parking.

### Terrain

A mix of pasture & scrub heathland with some brambles, bracken & trees and an extensive path network. Longer courses will visit areas of mixed woodland. With good weather, you'll have superb views of Golden Cap & the Jurassic Coast. However, the area has very steep slopes and the blue and green courses contain a higher degree of climb than usual... (If concerned about this, we suggest "dropping down" a course.)

### Courses

Orange, Short Green, Green and Blue

Start times: 10.30-12.00 Courses close: 14.00

There will be two start blocks near each other and close to parking area, but appropriately socially distanced from each other.

At each start there will be one competitor starting every minute, allowing for a maximum of 150 entries. When entering on Fabian4, competitors must select a 15-minute start block.

If all slots are full before the closing date, the last start time may be extended.

Loose control descriptions will NOT be available in the start blocks, but will be made available to be printed during the week prior to the event. They will be on the maps.
