**Free Parking on hard standing at campsite**
- Terrain:** All courses use Ocknell Inclosure and plain, an area of mixed forest and fast open heathland.  
The longer courses also use Lucas Castle which is mainly fast heathland.
- Map:** 1:10,000 remapped late 2018 and updates 2021
- Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown
- Facilities:** **Toilets. Catering Tom & Julie Wilkinson**  
Dogs allowed under close control in Assembly only.
- Timing:** Registration from 10.00am. Start times 10.30am – 12.30pm  
Courses close promptly at 2.30pm  
The event will use SIAC enabled Sport Ident punching
- Cost:** £12 Senior (£2 supplement for Non BOF members), £6 Juniors (Seniors on white/yellow/orange £6)
