Urban area please respect residents. Safety bearing north west back to main road.

Fees: Seniors £5.00. Juniors £2 (must be accompanied by an adult)

Entries: No entries on the day. See list of **those originally entered** for this event below.

Contactless card payment on the night can be taken if necessary but you must reserve a map
