<b>Location &amp; directions</b>	<p>The event centre is Tidworth Leisure Centre, Nadder Rd, Tidworth SP9 7QN what3words: ///unloads.without.surround</p> <p>We have been informed that the Pewsey to Everleigh road is in the middle of a 4 month shutdown, so travel via Upavon or Burbage if you are coming from Chippenham/Bristol.</p>
<b>Entries</b>	<p>Via RaceSignUp. Late entries (subject to map availability) £14 (£&amp; junior) +£2 surcharge for non BOF Members <b>Under 12's may be shadowed by an adult – please let the registration team know if you intend to do this.</b></p>
<b>Timing</b>	<p><b>Registration and Start Times</b> Car Park open from 09:45 Registration/enquiries, including hire dibber collection and EOD, open from 10.00 to 12:00 Start times: 10:30 - 12:30. There will be no pre-allocated start times. Go to the Start when you are ready. Courses close 14:00. You must report to Download by this time. Please ensure that you start early enough that you will be able to complete your course by the time courses close. Both the start and finish are within 200m of Registration.</p>
<b>Parking, assembly &amp; facilities</b>	<p>Car parking is in the Leisure Centre car park. <b>This will also be used by the other centre customers, so please car-share if possible.</b> Vehicles that cannot fit in a normal car parking bay may be directed to the N of the centre. Please park as directed.</p> <p>Assembly: Registration, download and first aid are in a large room on the first floor.</p> <p>Toilets: there are toilets accessed via the assembly room. Additional toilets are on the ground floor, with wet and dry changing rooms (which will be shared with other centre users)</p> <p>Food and drink: There is a café inside the Leisure Centre serving coffee and cakes/pastries. They are opening especially for us, so please support them. There</p>

	<p>is also a café in the Civic Centre, 300m from the Leisure Centre. There are also large supermarkets in Tidworth town centre.</p> <p><b>No dogs allowed (including in car park or on courses).</b></p> <p><b>Please leave dirty shoes outside the Leisure Centre and keep the Leisure Centre grounds free of rubbish.</b></p>
<b>Terrain</b>	<p>Typical urban terrain comprising Tidworth Leisure Centre grounds and surrounding urban area, with playing fields and parks. Metal studded/spiked shoes are not suitable, but shoes with some grip will be needed.</p>
<b>Map</b>	<p>Scale 1:5,000 Contours 5m Control descriptions will be printed the maps with loose descriptions in the start lanes. Course 7 will have written control descriptions on the map</p> <p><b>Non-IOF symbols on map:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>X Play or Fitness equipment</li><li>○ Benches/picnic tables (not all mapped as some prone to moving)</li></ul> <p>Very small black square – round or square drain cover – mainly brick/concrete – can be quite large and very visible if you encounter one</p> <p>There have been many new trees planted – mainly in the north park area – most are small (1-2m high) with a post and green water bag attached. These are not shown on the map.</p> <p><b>Out of Bounds (OOB) Areas</b></p> <p>Please ensure that you are familiar with the symbols for OOB features. No impassable wall or fence may be crossed, neither may vegetation (often hedges) mapped as green/black be crossed – even if there appears to a passable gap. Also, areas mapped in olive green are also not to be entered.</p> <p>Other out of bounds areas are marked on the map by the normal purple line overprint.</p>

<b>Start, SI, Finish</b>	<p>Start – signed from event centre 100m Finish - 200m follow taped route back to assembly and download.</p> <p>There is a punching start and the start and finish must be punched. SIAC will be enabled. Loose control descriptions will be in the start lanes.</p>			
<b>Safety</b>	<p><b>First Aid</b> will be available in the Assembly Area inside the indoor hall.</p> <p>For anyone with a <b>pre-existing medical condition</b>, we would strongly encourage you to leave a note with the registration team in case of emergency. This information is confidential and will be destroyed by the Organiser immediately after the event.</p> <p>Adult courses include <b>multiple road crossings</b> – please take extreme care when doing so. There are two compulsory road crossings across the A338. These will be timed out.</p>			

	<p>Please be mindful and give way to local residents, shoppers and other users such as cyclists and dog walkers .</p> <p>'Stranger danger'. Juniors should be reminded by their carers that if they feel unsafe at any time, they should speak to any member of the start/finish teams, or another orienteer.</p> <p><b>Competitors are strongly recommended to wear bright, high-viz clothing</b></p>
